KEY POINTS - take a minute to review the key points from this weekend's message

- 1. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life of our entire being
- 2. Ways that make Jesus unique:
 - a. The atonement:
 - i. We're not saved by believing in ourselves. We're saved by believing in Jesus.
 - b. The Resurrection:
 - i. 11 of the 12 disciples died because of their faith in the resurrection. Without Jesus rising from the dead, we have no faith.
 - c. Grace:
 - i. Only Christianity teaches the unconditional love of God, with no strings attached and free of charge
- 3. All religions can't be equal because Jesus Christ is equal to no one
